# Recovered paper purchase specification

EN 643:2014 grade definitions apply. This specification covers imports made under the Turkish buyer mill's importer registration and environmental permits; mill-specific additional terms are stated in the offer.

## 1. Grades and limits

## 2. Bales and loading

- Bale weight 1.0–1.3 t; wire-tied (minimum 4 wires); bale dimensions suitable for container loading
- 40' HC container: 23–25 t; loading photos (empty, half, full, doors closed, seal) sent with the shipment
- Bale list: bale count, gross/net weight, container and seal number

## 3. Documents

- Commercial invoice, packing list, bill of lading
- Annex VII (Regulation (EC) 1013/2006 / Basel) — with the buyer's importer registration details
- Pre-shipment inspection report (third-party survey where requested)
- Radioactivity and moisture are measured on arrival; moisture governs weight adjustment

## 4. Non-conformity

Where moisture or contamination exceeds the limits, the buyer notifies within 14 days with photographs and weighbridge tickets; weight adjustment or price allowance is applied by agreement. Rejection per bale is reserved.
